



2010 Earth Day Poster Contest

Title of the poster is "Earth Says ..."

Contest Rules

Ask each student to create a poster that reflects his or her understanding of the important role trees and recycling play in cities, town, the earth. Before they create their poster, encourage students to think about the variety of ways trees and recycling benefit their community and themselves. Students should make sure their poster follows the contest rules by using the checklist below.

1. Submit entry by designated deadline to your teacher.
2. All entries must be original artwork created by a student who is currently in the 5th thru 6th grade. A student may enter the contest only once.
3. The student's first and last name must be written or signed in the lower right-hand corner on the front of the poster.
4. Entries may be done in marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, and/or tempera paint.
 - o Collages are not acceptable. (Do not glue anything on your poster.)
 - o Computer or photo generated art and/or printing is not acceptable.
 - o Entries should not display the names of commercial products, companies, or organizations.
5. Entries must be no smaller than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 18."
6. Entries must be done on paper that will allow for duplication, display, and framing.
7. The poster must be related to the contest theme in some way. The theme Earth Says...! must be on the poster. All words must be spelled correctly.
8. Entries should not be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, or folded.
